KICKS OFF ITS SIXTH SEASON APRIL 7**

Atlanta's only in-town weekday lunch market to open 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. every Thursday

Atlanta, April 4, 2016 – Peachtree Center, downtown Atlanta's iconic mixed-use development, will again welcome the popular Peachtree Center Green Market starting on Thursday, April 7 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the courtyard. The market will continue each Thursday through October, and offer a unique lunchtime experience for those who work in and visit downtown.

This mid-day market in Peachtree Center's courtyard features over a dozen vendors selling local goods from produce to breads to juice. Cosmos Organic Farm, Pearson Farms and Sweet Auburn Bread are returning for 2016, and exciting new vendors this year include Banjo Cold Brew Coffee and The Allergy-Friendly Vegetarian. In addition to the all-star vendor list, the Peachtree Center Green Market will present live music from local musicians each week.

"The Peachtree Center Green Market is a unique way to bring the downtown community together over lunch," said Marti Blackstock, with Banyan Street Capital, owner and operator of Peachtree Center. "People come to the market each week from all over downtown to grab fresh peaches, delicious pastries and other locally grown and prepared fresh foods to enjoy at lunch or take home. Peachtree Center is truly the heart and soul of downtown Atlanta, and events such as the Green Market contribute to the town square-like feel of the courtyard."

This local market is unique because it occurs on a weekday during lunch time, allowing tens of thousands of downtown workers to have access to fresh, healthy food and experience a welcome mid-day break in an urban oasis, all without getting in a vehicle. For those outside of downtown, the market is easily accessible by MARTA, bike or car.

"The Peachtree Center Green Market is like a breath of fresh air on Peachtree Street," said Lynn Williamson, marketing and creative director at Central Atlanta Progress. "From fresh produce, house-made jams, bakery items to live music, it evokes images of

a bustling town square. The market is weekly delight that downtown workers and residents look forward to each Thursday.”

- **Banjo Cold Brew Coffee:** Specialty-grade, cold brew coffee made with locally roasted fair-trade beans.
- **Bee Wild Honey:** Local raw honey and honey-based products.
- **Bernhard's German Bakery:** Local fresh-baked breads, bagels, pastries, and other treats.
- **Boston Brittle Company:** Gourmet, corn syrup free brittles.
- **Cosmos Organic Farm:** A diverse array of seasonal vegetables, fruits, mushrooms, and flowers, all locally and organically grown.
- **Golda Kombucha:** Home-brewed kombucha tea.
- **Lumeria Body Care:** Artisanal soaps, deodorants, body scrubs, bath soaks, bath teas, beard and hair oil, skin balms, and butter moisturizers made with all natural ingredients.
- **Merrily Gardens:** Gourmet jams, pickled vegetables, chutneys, sauces, honeys, salsas, and gift bags, boxes and baskets.
- **Pearson Farms:** Peaches, pecans, pecan oils, strawberries (mid-April), Georgia shrimp (mid-April), and Georgia apples (late August).
- **Stoneridge Foods:** Gourmet cookies, sandwich crèmes, stuffed cookies, seasonally made cakes, seasoned cracker mixes and dipping blends, sea salt blends, pepperoni rolls, vanilla infusion kits, and hot chocolate kits (fall).
- **Suja Juice:** Organic, non-GMO, cold-pressed juice.
- **Sweet Auburn Bread:** Local, small-batch seasonal ingredient muffins, cookies, brownies, loaf breads, pies, cobblers, cheesecakes, biscuits, yeast breads and cinnamon rolls, jams, preserves, butters, jellies and syrups.
- **Sweet Sassy Molassey Bakeshop:** Traditional baked goods made with healthier ingredients.
- **The Allergy-Friendly Vegetarian:** Baked goods free from the 8 most common food allergens and corn, sesame, and gluten.
