ATLANTA (March 28, 2017) – Peachtree Center, Downtown Atlanta's iconic mixed-use development, will welcome the popular Peachtree Center Green Market for its seventh season starting on Thursday, April 6 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. The market will continue each Thursday through October and offer a unique lunchtime experience for those who work, shop and visit in Downtown Atlanta.

This local market is unique because it occurs on a weekday during lunch time, allowing tens of thousands of Downtown workers to have access to fresh, healthy food and experience a welcome mid-day break in an urban oasis, all without getting in a vehicle. For those outside of Downtown, the market is easily accessible by MARTA, bike or car.
